

Criminal Code Art. 116

The Croatian criminal legislation shall be applied to a Croatian citizen or a person with permit residence who outside the Croatian territory commits a criminal offence provided it is punishable under the law of the country in which it was committed. In cases with respect to criminal offences referred to, inter alia, Article 116 (FGM) of the Criminal Code and other provided for by international treaties to which Croatia is a party, the Croatian criminal legislation shall also be applied under the conditions laid down by those documents.

Availability of information collecting system or reports

The Ministry of Justice is responsible for the criminal records. The Ministry provides direct access to criminal records data to courts and prosecutors in relation to a person against whom criminal proceedings were started. The Ministry also provides criminal records data to the police and prosecutors for the purpose of prevention and detection of criminal offences and offenders. Not a single FGM case has not been so far recorded (last checked in June 2014).
