

Cypriot Criminal Code, CAP 154, (last amendment (4) 2011), Provision 135

Targeted professionals: *All public officers, including medical practitioners, police officers, legal officers of the Service of the Attorney General, are bound by this provision not to disclose state or official (service) information.

Professional Secrecy Provisions

Conditions for disclosing information

*Information can only be disclosed after authorisation.

Right or duty to report

*Public officials have a duty to report any abuse of other public officers but they rarely do in practice.

Existence of disciplinary sanctions in case of non-reporting

*Maximum two years imprisonment or 2543.88 Euros or both sanctions.
