

Law 3625/2007 incorporating the Optional protocol for the Protection of the Rights of the Child (Greece)

This law mainly focuses on child trafficking, child prostitution and the selling of children's organs. It is important to note that this law provides for the prohibition of corporate violence and not corporate punishment of the child, thus providing for a wider scope of protection.
