Professional Secrecy Provisions

Conditions for disclosing information

The doctor has to notify the Child Welfare Service in their district if they treat an injured child and it can be assumed that the injury is the result of negligence or abuse or if the doctor otherwise learns about child abuse or negligence

Right or duty to report

Duty to report to child welfare service

Existence of disciplinary sanctions in case of non-reporting

Disciplinary sanctions in case of non-reporting. Criminal procedures might also be initiated (Endangering a person under work duty, Article 171 of the Penal Code).
