Main themes of our projects and areas of activity include: gender responsive budgets; gender and education; civil society and democracy; gender equality in working life, work and family life; human trafficking and prostitution; sustainable development and gender equality. The topic of reconciling work and family has been an important one for ENUT for several years; it has focused on it as concerns both women/mothers and men/fathers. Since 2008 gender and education (eg. rigid gender prescriptions and choices for girls and boys, addressing gender stereotypes) has also been a priority area of activity.
