

Note on Brexit and UK-specific content on EIGE's website

The United Kingdom left the EU on 31 January 2020, with the transition period covered by the EU-UK Withdrawal Agreement coming to a close on 31 December 2020.

As of 1 January 2021, the UK will no longer be referred to as an EU member state in new content published on EIGE's website.
