- Lot 2 - Gender-sensitive language review in Eastern Europe languages: Bulgarian, Croatian, Czech, Polish, Slovak, Slovene, Latvian and Lithuanian.
- Lot 3 - Gender-sensitive language review in Western and southern Europe languages: French, Italian, Portuguese, Romanian, Spanish, Greek and Maltese.

The overall objective is to ensure that EIGE's publications and/or website texts are gender-sensitive, clear, easy to read and engaging for policy makers and non-expert audiences, in all official EU languages other than English.
