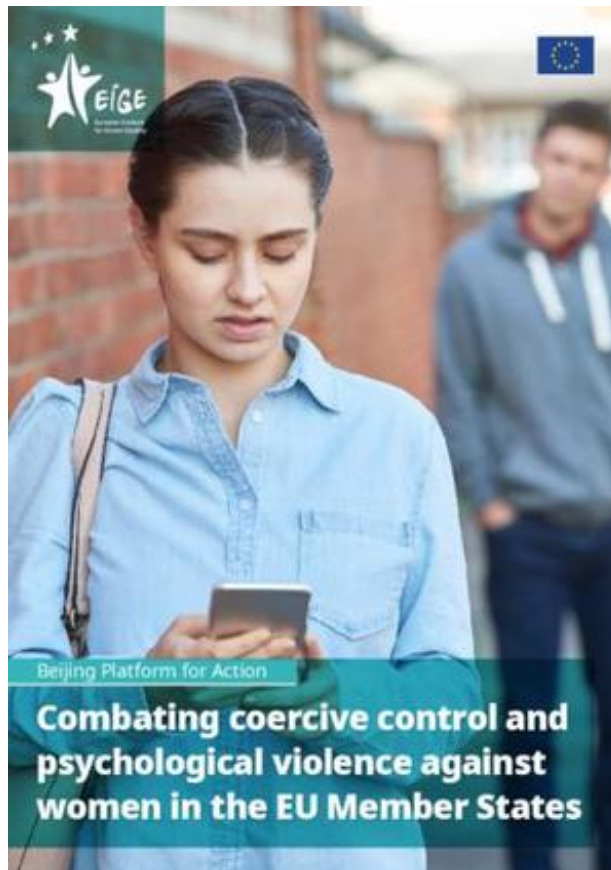


Combating coercive control and psychological violence against women in the EU Member States
