Ending violence against women is a challenge because we don't yet have reliable and comparable data to show decision-makers just how common it is. This also means that government institutions and victim support services often understand EIGE is working on a project that aims to help policymakers make better decisions across the EU regarding their data collection. This will help us to understand the true scale and impact of intimate partner violence.
