A compelling business case speaks to multiple target groups and secures buy-in through providing evidence on feasibility and effectiveness.

The purpose of collecting information about the impact of work-life balance policies is to quantify the real value of such programmes and possible future initiatives by assessing hidden costs and calculating economic benefits to the organisation.
