### Code system used

\* The Criminology Statistical System includes indicators of the risk assessment: i1 (physical violence), i2 (sexual violence), i3 (weapon use), i4 (explicit threats or plans of physical or sexual violence against the victim), i5 (escalation and or recurrence of incidents or threats of violence e) i6 (psychological violence) i7 (psychical violence), damage to the house, objects or goods of the victim, i8(breach of the protection court, criminal or civil orders protecting the rights of victims) ( i9 (breach of criminal sentences, custodial or not), i10 (defiant and contemptuous behaviour toward the authorities and their agents) i11 (offending criminal or police history of the perpetrator no related to the partner), i12 (toxic/alcohol/drug abuse), i13 (attitude, values or habits of the offender that promoting, justify or play down violence), i14 (clear problems in the couple relationship), i15 (work / financial problems of the perpetrator) i16 (suicidal tendencies)
