**Other:**

All information about a person and argumentation to receive a support is done on paper and submitted to the municipality where a person has official residence. Later information about assigned services for a person is submitted electronically in the database of municipality which is transferred to the central database, managed by the Ministry of Social Security and Labour.

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## Quality assurance process

The legal act indicates that a person himself/herself writes an application with a request for social support. The sharing of data with other registers such as Residence Register, Social insurance Register, Labour Exchange, Property Register indicates the accuracy of entering the data and correction if any mistake appears
