Reliability

Limitations. Data arrive on a paper register and have to be elaborated, cleaned and interpreted. * Over time. Data are not comparable over time as there has been a wide modification in the methodology of investigation on reported crimes for which the penal action has been initiated. In addition, since 2006 some public prosecutors's offices have started a migration process between different information systems, with a consequent impact on the data.

A part from the conclusion of the migration process of raw data from paper form to digital form, the expectation is that these data will feed police data base house Another expected development is the possibility to use data on victims
