Additional information: Data are registered at the local level. Codes for this registration are provided at the national level. There are 27 local databases, which are all connected to the national database. Data cannot be extracted at the local level, only at the national level. Parameters used are identical for all local databases. Datasets are cleared out, organized and saved by statistical analysts. They check raw data and correct data where necessary.

Compilation

Data extracted from 27 local databases, at the national level.

Quality assurance process

- Yes

Brief description: Statistical analysts check and correct data. Data are being abstracted at the national level, to assure comparability. Codes for registering data are defined at the national level. Local databases are connected to national database Gatherings between statistical analysts and information managers, to guarantee uniform registration.

Accuracy

No information. Dark number. Figures cannot be used to get insight into prevalence of crime, but to gain insight in workings of justice system.

Reliability

Good. Guidelines provided in circulars and work of statistical analysts make sure that data are being registered uniformly.

Timeliness

Good. Data are registered ongoing at the local level. Once a year, statistics are being abstracted and reported about the previous year.
