

Short film contest -es+ against gender violence ("Less is More", film to be the voice of those who are silent)

It involved a short film contest concerning different aspects of gender violence paying special attention to the experiences of victims. The contest winner was "live or die". It reported in about 1:53 minutes the abuse process through four time points that form a single scene. The film highlighted the ability of women to decide.
