Examining forced marriages, honour killings, female genital mutilation and honour-based domestic violence, the report explains why such violence is carried out and why it continues. Based on over 80 interviews with women's groups, community activists and the victims of honour-based violence, the report is the most comprehensive study of honour-based violence ever conducted in the UK.
