*There are no specific provisions on FGM. It is possible that the following can be used: Article 25 (4) of the Child Protection Law - Reasons for removing the child from the family: "when the child is a victim of violence in the family and there is a serious danger of impairing his/her physical, psychological, moral, intellectual or social development"
