## Professional Secrecy Provisions

### Conditions for disclosing information

The psychologist may disclose information to the care-taker of a person if they deem that not disclosing would aggravate the mental health of their client. The psychologist may also disclose information to the parent if they deem that disclosure will not harm the child.

### Right or duty to report

Right to disclose information to parents or care-takers under certain conditions
