

Bill from the Initiative of Deputies Aloï et al. Dispositions regarding prohibition of Female Genital Mutilations

The bill proposes to define excision, infibulation and clitoridectomy as crimes and to punish them with 7 to 12 years of imprisonment, 6 to 12 years aid and abet. Maximum penalties if to commit the crime were parents of the victim, who shall lose parental authority. Health care professionals involved to be permanently banned from the profession; administrative sanctions to structures which have hosted the criminal.
