

# House of Commons Education Committee Written Evidence - The Child Protection System in England (prepared 15 November 2011)

This is written evidence received and accepted by the Education Committee as evidence for the ongoing inquiry of the Child Protection System in England. Evidence was presented by several actors from governmental and non governmental agencies. A few questions were posed to the witnesses submitting the evidence including: Whether the child protection system allowed for the effective identification of, and early help to, children at risk of different forms of abuse and exploitation (including, but not restricted to: neglect, sexual and physical abuse, domestic violence, forced marriage, female genital mutilation, child trafficking and online exploitation);
