Professional Secrecy Provisions

Conditions for disclosing information

To have knowledge of a committed crime.

Right or duty to report

Duty to report for anyone who due to their status or profession has knowledge about a committed crime.

Existence of disciplinary sanctions in case of non-reporting

A fine and in case of civil servants an administrative sanction
