Steps to effective police risk assessment of intimate partner violence

- 1 | Define the purpose and objectives of police risk assessment
- 2 | Identify the most appropriate approach to police risk assessment
- 3 | Identify the most relevant risk factors for police risk assessment
- 4 | Implement systematic police training and capacity development
- 5 | Embed police risk assessment in a multiagency framework

- 6 | Develop procedures for information management and confidentiality
- 7 | Monitor and evaluate risk assessment practices and outcomes
