This allowed to develop the specific recommendations for each ministry. The initiative was a part of the project "Equal Treatment - a Standard of Good Governance"

The survey, with the extended indicator "Gender Index" which included diversity, was conducted by the project partner - Warsaw School of Economics and embraced almost all ministries (1 refused to participate). It focused on the specific areas where the discrimination may occur (recruitment, combining family life and work, trainings and promotion, remuneration) and intended to check to what extent are the ministries prepared to implement equality strategies.
