

Mother's Labour Market Participation and Local Availability of Childcare. Evidence From Luxembourg

In this paper, we analyze the effect of local availability of childcare on mother's labour market participation. We use a bivariate probit model to explain both labour market participation and child care use of mothers. The main results confirm that the local availability of child care has a positive effect on mother's labour market participation and child care use. Estimations from specific groups of mothers suggest that the size of this effect is not negligible.
