

# Central and Eastern Europe in Transition : Children at Risk in Central and Eastern Europe : Perils and Promises; Economies in Transition Studies; Regional Monitoring Report No.4

The fourth report analyses eight types of risk threatening the 100 million children in the 18 countries of Central and Eastern Europe and the Caucasus: poverty, war and displacement, environmental degradation, deteriorating health services, family breakdown, reduced access to education, risk youth life styles, and juvenile crime. It also includes an analysis of children in institutions, highlighting the rise in their numbers.
