
Centres of Excellence? The role of Children's Centres in early intervention.

This report suggests that supporting high quality care for children from deprived backgrounds provides greater value for money than giving subsidies to the richest parents. It argues that Children's Centres will only be sustainable if they focus on helping families in the most deprived areas. It also argues for greater clarity over how individual centres are performing, with greater transparency over funding.
