

# Activity of Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe

---

## Aims and objectives

The aim of the Council of Europe, which has 47 Member States, is to achieve greater unity among its members through common action, agreements and debates. The conditions for membership are pluralistic democracy, the rule of law and respect for human rights. The Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE) consists of a number of individual representatives from each member State. They meet four times a year to discuss topical issues and ask European governments to take initiatives and report back. In 2008 the Assembly agreed a Recommendation on involving men in gender equality, based on a report from the Committee on Equal Opportunities for Women and Men.
