The objective is to identify effective approaches and mechanisms implemented in EU Member States to collect administrative data, with specific concern on data from police, justice, health, social services and the “other” administrative systems (i.e. related ministries, ombudsperson, ...) .The main aim is to assess those mechanisms that facilitate a systematic collection of comparable data in order to reflect the number of reported cases and also to enable the monitoring of actions taken to eradicate violence against women.
