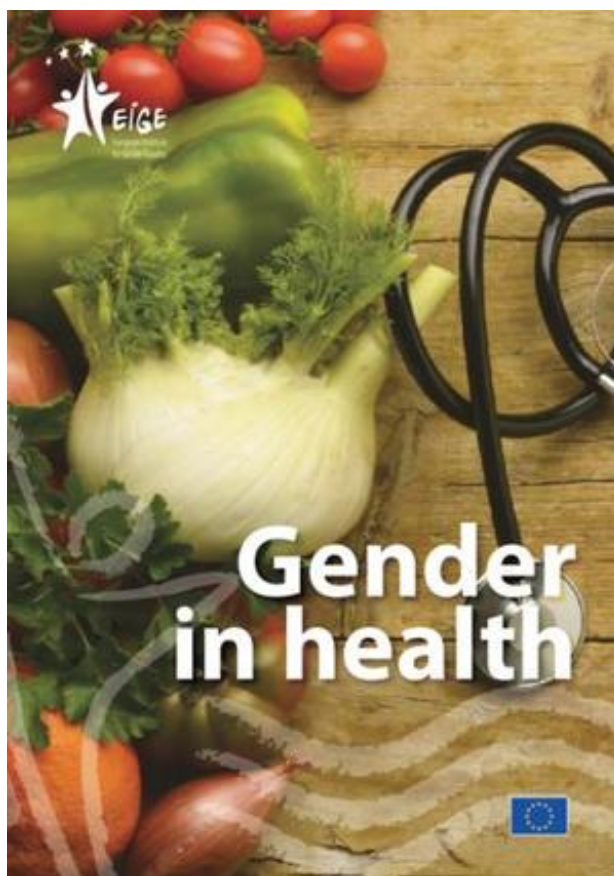


Gender in health
