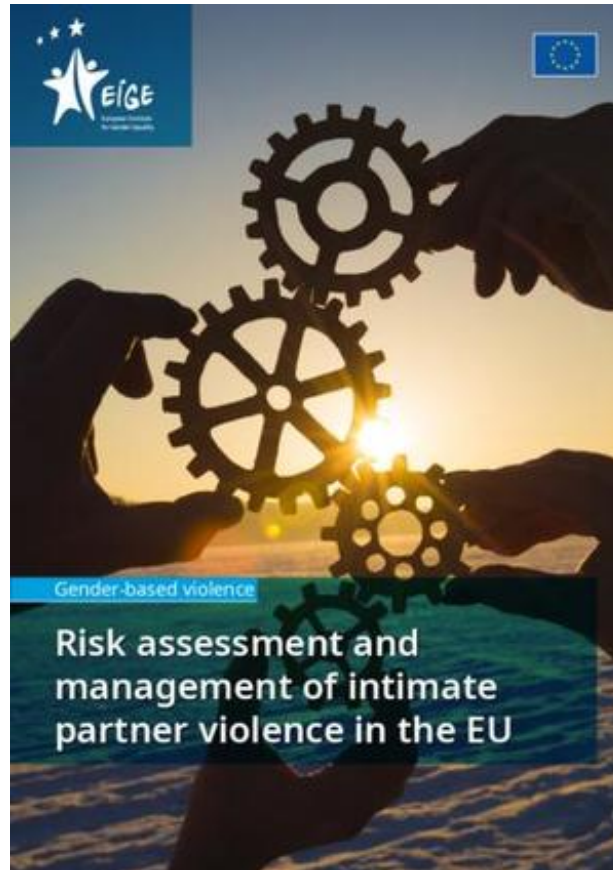


Risk assessment and management of intimate partner violence in the EU

They are often the first authority victims turn to for protection, especially in countries where police are trusted. Risk assessment and risk management strategies are two vital steps that ensure the immediate safety of victims and prevent further violence. EIGE's [guidelines and recommendations](#) offer a common EU-wide approach to risk assessment and risk management.

To complement these guidelines, EIGE has also published this report, which maps risk assessment policy measures, legal provisions and research developments across the EU. This research builds upon the institute's previous work supporting Member States in strengthening their responses to intimate partner violence.
