Who is eligible for parental leave in Portugal?

Parental leave is granted to parents, usually after maternity and paternity leave, allowing mothers and fathers to take care of their young children without losing their jobs. Such a policy exists in all EU Member States and in Portugal it is called Licença parental complementar. The policy design and eligibility rules vary across the EU and not all women and men in the EU are eligible for parental leave.

Parental leave in Portugal is:

- Paid
- 6 months
- Part of the leave is transferable between parents and/or is an individual right

3 % of women and 3 % of men in employment are not eligible for parental leave

This factsheet is based on an eligibility study of how many women and men aged 20-49 would be eligible for parental leave if they had a child in 2017 and the reasons behind their non-eligibility (1).

Who is eligible for parental leave in Portugal?

- ✓ Employees (self-employed)
- ✓ Self-employed (self-employed)
- ✗ Same-sex parents
- ✓ Non-citizens (2)

In the EU-28 (3):

- 15 countries restrict access to employees with short working duration before birth (including Portugal)
- The self-employed are not eligible in 10 countries (not Portugal but some conditions apply)
- 17 countries do not allow access for same-sex parents (including Portugal)
- 15 limit access to refugees or asylum seekers (not Portugal)

In Portugal, duration conditions for the employee and the self-employed restrict the access to parental leave.

Gender	Not eligible for parental leave	Eligible for parental leave
Women	3%	97%
Men	3%	97%

(1) Reasons for ineligibility include: refugees and asylum seekers when they apply for asylum in the afternoon, no combination of eligible (2) Women share categories: multidimensional and over 40 or 50 years, 30 country members, refugees and asylum seekers (3) The facts available before the 2018th European election
