## Questions and Answers

### Question:

We are concerned about the feasibility of activity 6 as specified on p.6 of the ToR: “To collect all the Member States policy initiatives related to climate change in the sectors of transport and energy, analyse them from the perspective of gender equality and present them in the form of a separate analysis paper”.

While we consider that it would be possible to provide examples of climate change policies in those sectors from a variety (or even all) Member States and then analyse them from a gender perspective, we do not believe that it would be possible, with the available budget, to collect all Member State policy initiatives in these sectors, unless you have a particular existing source of such policies which you would provide to the successful contractor.

### Answer:

The contractor is supposed to identify and review only the approved policy initiatives related to climate change in all 27 EU Member States within sectors of transport and energy. These identified policy initiatives in force have to be analysed to find out if the gender perspective has been taken into account. This analysis shall be presented by the contractor in a separate report. The most successful initiatives identified during the analysis could be highlighted.

EIGE does not intend to present the successful bidder any inventory on policy initiatives. This information has to be collected by the contractor.
