How many women have top positions in the EU candidate countries and potential candidates?

EIGE's Gender Statistics Database has expanded beyond the current EU Member States. We can now monitor how gender-balance in decision-making is developing also in the Western Balkan countries and Turkey, which are part of the EU programme called the Instrument for Preaccession Assistance (IPA). EIGE supports the IPA countries in their efforts to monitor and foster gender equality in the region. This is what the latest data shows.





Data collection process

Phase 1: Desk research (Nov '18 – Feb '19)



- Dedicated country researchers for 30 jurisdictions
- Review of government, agencies and national statistical institutes' websites
- Population of data collection tool (xlsx) with data and metadata

Phase 2: Validation (Feb '19 – ongoing)

- Requests sent via email and phone
- Named contacts at relevant organisations (Police, Home Ministries, Justice Ministries, Courts...) were approached
- Validation obtained on available (meta)data and missing (metadata)data





Proxy and missing data

- No disaggregation by sex, age or victimperpetrator relationship
- Data only on victim or only on offence
- No data on IPV (often: Domestic violence)
- Data not centrally/digitally collected

Next steps

- Final validation for some jurisdictions
- Publication of data and data collection tools on EIGE's Gender Statistics Database






Data publication in EIGE's Database

- Data that adhere to EIGE's definition will be displayed in EIGE's Database
- Data will be displayed in dedicated data tables for each indicator



Data publication in EIGE's Database

- Data is accompanied by a metadata page providing information about the data and data collection. This page adheres to SDMX (Statistical Data and Metadata eXchange) standards
- In addition, a dedicated metadata document will accompany the data setting out all caveats that affects data comparability







Data publication in EIGE's Database

 The collection tool (xlsx) will also be available for download for each country individually from the metadata by clicking on a hyperlink

The table below provides links to Excel files for each country with all data and metadata collected (including non-comparable approximates) for each of the 13 indicators defined by EIGE. In the second column, any nuances to comparable data as provided in data table in EIGE's Gender Statistics Database are described, where relevant (as indicated by the flag (d) (definition differs, see metadata) in the data table).
