



# Gender Equality Index 2017: Progress at a snail's pace



### NEWS ARTICLE II October 2017

The updated Gender Equality Index shows where Europe stands today. We are moving forward but overall progress is very slow. The EU's score is just four points higher than ten years ago, now 66.2 out of 100. The top performing country is Sweden with a score of 82.6, while Greece moved to the bottom with 50 points. The award for the most improved country goes to Italy, which made a big leap and gained 12.9 points to place itself at rank 14 on the ladder.

Gender Equality Index 2015: Finland

The Gender Equality Index is a unique measurement tool that synthesises the complexity of gender equality into a user-friendly and easy to understand measure. Based on the EU policy framework, it assists the monitoring of progress in gender equality across the European Union over time.

The Geneter Equality Index constats of its core domains (work, morey, knowledge, time, power and health) and two satellite domains (violence and interesting inequalities). It is calculated by combining geneter indicators into a single summary measure. The Gender Equality Index assigns scores for Member States of between 1 for total equality and 100 for Idia guality. It measures gender gaps between women and men, kalling into account the engeality and 100 for Idia guality. The Gender Equality Index 2015 measures how far (or close to) the EU and its Member States were from achieving gender equality in 2005, 2010 and 2012 [). It provides results for each domain and subdomain. It also presents the first attempt to calculate a composite measure for violence against women.

#### Progress in gender equality in Finland since 2005

With an increase in the score 0.2 points, progress in Finland's more promounced than the U2-3a array, The courtry has a score of **72.7 out of 100**, which remains one of the highest scores amongst U3 Member States. However, challenges persist in some areas. The greatest challenges remain in the unequal distribution of time declated to dometic, care and lesure activities between women and men.
