
Published Gender Equality Indices, for 2014 and 2016

Work on Gender Equality Index for 2018



- The Gender Equality Index (GEI) for the Republic of Serbia for 2018 has been calculated and the plan is to publish the final report in 2021.
- The index was prepared with close cooperation and with the support of the European Institute for Gender Equality (EIGE).
- Given that the EIGE methodology was used, the results are comparable to the EU-27 and EU countries.

Digitalisation and the future of Work

is prepared as a thematic focus for Serbia GEI 2021 Report too.

Current state of play – indicators and data



- The SORS team provided data for all indicators for the calculation of the GEI for the Republic of Serbia.
- Majority of indicators and data for Serbia are available in Eurostat and EIGE Gender statistics database.

GEI for EU and Serbia

- The Republic of Serbia is on EU track – slow but positive trend of the GEI.
- A snail's pace towards gender equality.



Current state of play – new data sources & updates



- EHIS 2019 data are ready and published on SORS web site.
- EU survey on Gender-Based violence against women and other forms of inter-personal Violence (EU-GBV) will be conducted in Serbia in autumn 2021 for the first time. The pilot survey was conducted in autumn 2020.
- Time Use Survey 2021 fieldwork is ongoing. There are two additional questions on stress before and after the pandemic.
