Description of the requested services:

The main output of the study shall be a comprehensive report containing the findings of the analytic review and assessment of the relative advantages and disadvantages of existing options for conducting costing studies on IPV across the EU. The report will include a feasibility study of different methodologies and will draw recommendations to estimate the economic impact of intimate partner violence against women (IPV) in the EU Member States.

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of the negotiated procurement procedure through which EIGE may award the above-mentioned contract.
