Subject: Ex-ante publicity notice for procurement procedure "Monitoring and assessment of gender statistics availability from international sources"

Description of the contract:

The European Institute for Gender Equality (EIGE) envisages awarding a low-value contract for the Monitoring and assessment of gender statistics availability from international sources.

Description of the requested services:

The study shall review data collected and gathered by EU bodies and main international organisations as well as the existing and planned activities addressing this subject.

The contractor will have to analyse the existing availability of gender statistics from international sources, assess its quality and relevance in order to support EIGE on the:

- updating process of the gender equality index and its use for gender analysis;
- maintenance, update and use of EIGE's database on gender statistics;
- identification of existing gender statistics gaps according to EU policy priorities, particularly in the framework of EIGE's cooperation with international data providers such as Eurostat, Eurofound, the Fundamental Rights Agency.

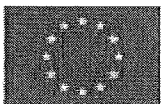
The contractor will analyse international statistical data sources that produce and publish statistics data and metadata at the EU level and/or which consider EU Member States. The contractor is to present a report reflecting the analysis done on the monitoring and assessment of gender statistics and a database with the relevant statistics data and metadata.

The format of the database needs to be compatible and in line with the structure of EIGE's database on gender statistics.

The information provided by the study will enable the Institute to avoid duplicate work, strengthen synergies and identify existing gaps for guiding its activities in the field of gender statistics.

Description of the procedure:

This ex-ante publicity is the first stage of the negotiated procurement procedure through which EIGE may award the above-mentioned contract.
