



## EIGE's Gender Equality Index



In 2015, EIGE will publish an updated Gender Equality Index. It will provide results for each Member State as regards their achievements in gender equality and the average for the EU 28 in the six core Domains: work, money, knowledge, time, power and health. For the first time a composite indicator for the satellite domain of violence will be available. EIGE's new interface will grant access to previously unavailable data (data comparisons for 2005, 2010 and 2012 are also presented). Check out EIGE's [Gender Equality Index](#).

## Gender statistics for better decision-making

By the end of 2015, EIGE will launch its new Gender Statistics Database. It is a comprehensive knowledge centre for gender statistics and information on various aspects of (in)equality between women and men.

The main purpose of this database is to build a broad overview of statistics on gender, highlighting differences and inequalities between both sexes. It will support the measurement of whether, or to what extent, gender equality is de facto being achieved. It will also act as a reliable resource in formulation and monitoring of policies that are beneficial for both women and men and will facilitate making appropriate decisions towards the advancement of gender equality.

## What is the cost of gender-based violence?

The cost of gender-based violence to the EU economies is substantial. The most recent in-depth [study](#) estimates the total cost of 258 billion Euros per annum for the EU. This figure demonstrates the urgent need for sustained preventive measures against gender-based violence. ### Number of resources available for online search has doubled

EIGE's [Resource and Documentation Centre \(RDC\)](#) has now more than 500,000 online resources available in several EU languages. This figure has doubled since last year.

Furthermore, EIGE has started the process for the creation of an EU-wide gender equality glossary and thesaurus. The project is being implemented in collaboration with EIGE's stakeholders, members of the Experts' forum, RDC partners, relevant EU institutions and representatives from academia.
