Gender-sensitive Parliaments Online Tool

An online tool designed as a self-assessment exercise to measure gender-sensitivity of parliaments.

The objectives of the Tool

- To collect data on participation of women and men in political decision-making, and the gender-sensitivity of organisational procedures and structures within a parliament;
- To highlight areas in which parliaments can enhance their gender-sensitivity;
- To provide a monitoring Tool for the parliaments.

How the Tool was developed

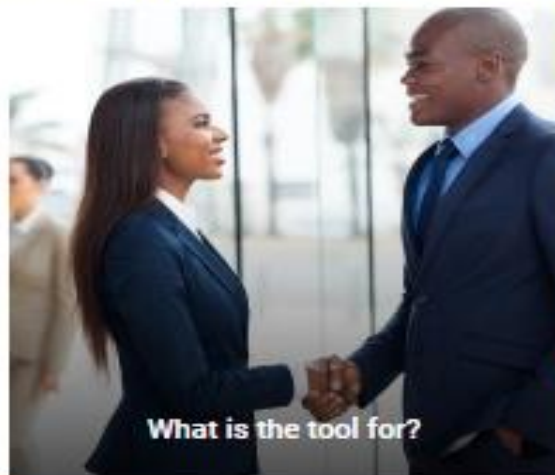
- Analytical report: literature review on the concept of 'gender-sensitive parliaments', good practices
- September 2016: meeting with parliamentary staff, international organisations (IPU, OSCE-ODIHR)
- Nov 2017-Jan 2018: Testing of the Tool with national and regional parliaments
- Revision of the Tool based on the tester feedback
- Expert meeting on scoring of the questions and weighting of indicators



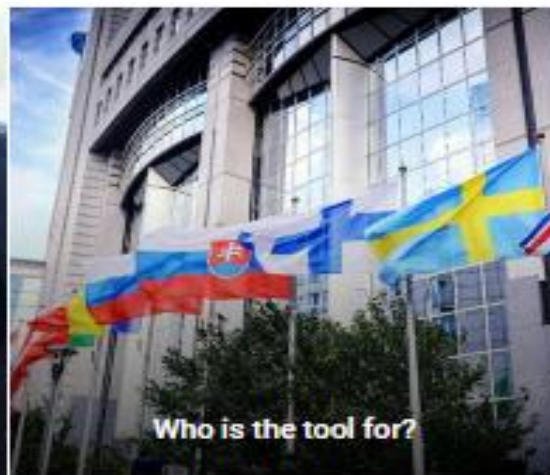

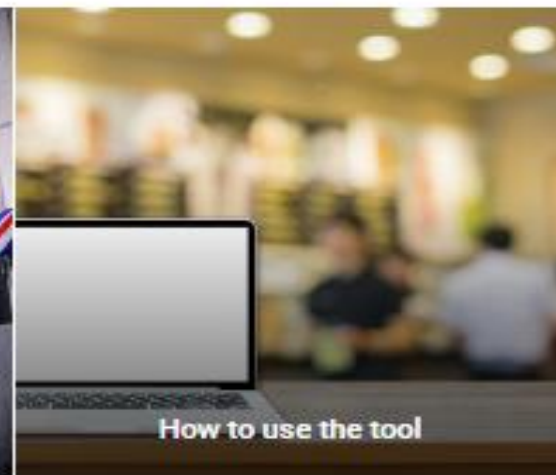

The five areas of the Tool

Women and men have equal opportunities to ENTER the parliament



Women and men have equal opportunities to INFLUENCE the parliament's working procedures



Women's interests and concerns have adequate SPACE on parliamentary agenda



The parliament produces gender-sensitive LEGISLATION



The parliament complies with its SYMBOLIC function
