Gender-sensitive Parliaments Online Tool

An online tool designed as a self-assessment exercise to measure gender-sensitivity of parliaments.

The objectives of the Tool

- To collect data on participation of women and men in political decision-making, and the gender-sensitivity of organisational procedures and structures within a parliament;
- To highlight areas in which parliaments can enhance their gender-sensitivity;
- To provide a monitoring Tool for the parliaments.





How the Tool was developed

- Analytical report: literature review on the concept of 'gender-sensitive parliaments', good practices
- September 2016: meeting with parliamentary staff, international organisations (IPU, OSCE-ODIHR)
- Nov 2017-Jan 2018: Testing of the Tool with national and regional parliaments
- Revision of the Tool based on the tester feedback
- Expert meeting on scoring of the questions and weighting of indicators



The five areas of the Tool

| Women and men have equal opportunities to ENTER the parliament | > |

| Women and men have equal opportunities to INFLUENCE the parliament's working procedures | > |
| Women's interests and concerns have adequate SPACE on parliamentary agenda | > |
| The parliament produces gender-sensitive LEGISLATION | > |
| The parliament complies with its SYMBOLIC function | > |
