



# **CRITERIA**

- Collaboration with designers of administrative systems and joint work with data suppliers is in place.
- Definitions of different forms of violence against women are harmonised with international/common ones.
- Data is made visible to increase awareness of violence in the society







## **CRITERIA**

- The integration of data and information on violence against women survivors and perpetrators and the relationship between them is present.
- The harmonisation of the definitions of different forms of violence against women on the basis of International Crime Classification System is present.
- The integration of data and information on violence against women from different sources to ensure comparability is taken into adequate consideration.
