Will three quarters of equality suffice for Finland?

This month, EIGE put the gender equality spotlight on Finland during its country visit. EIGE's Gender Equality Index shows that Finland is almost three quarters of the way to achieving equality between women and men. Although its score is high compared to the other 28 EU Member States, there is still room for improvement.

Men dominate positions of power in Eastern Partnership countries

The Eastern Partnership countries wanted to check the situation of gender equality in power and decision-making in their countries and carried out a study using EIGE's know-how. EIGE's study shows that important positions of power in the EU are predominately held by men, especially in the finance sector where only 1 in 25 top jobs are held by a woman. There is room for improvement also in EU's eastern neighbours, and they can now compare their results with each other and the EU.


Call for expressions of interest


