## Work

- Participation
- Segregation

Currently used two variables:

- Flexibility to take care of personal or family matters
- Intensity of work

**Intensity of work will be reviewed** (source: EWCS, 2015)

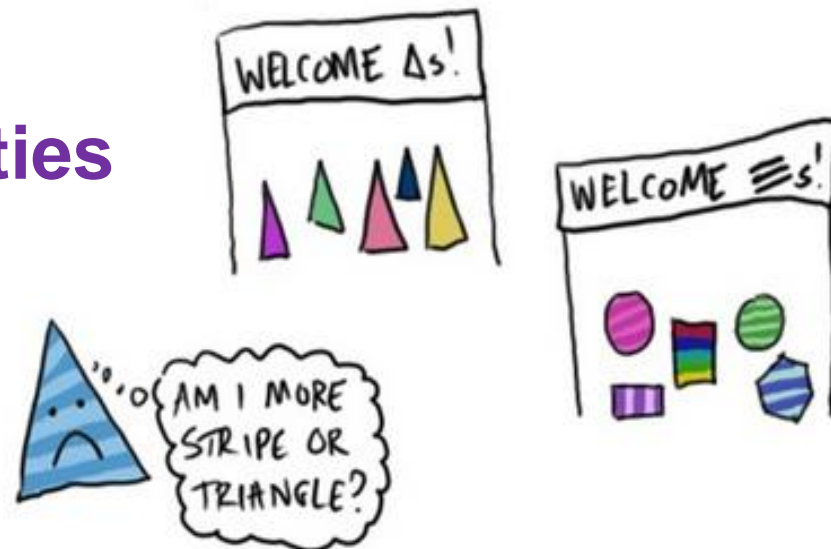
## Time

Currently used four variables:

- Workers taking care activities
- Workers doing cooking and housework
- Workers doing leisure activities
- Workers doing voluntary or charitable activities

**Non-workers will be included** (source: EWCS and EQLS)

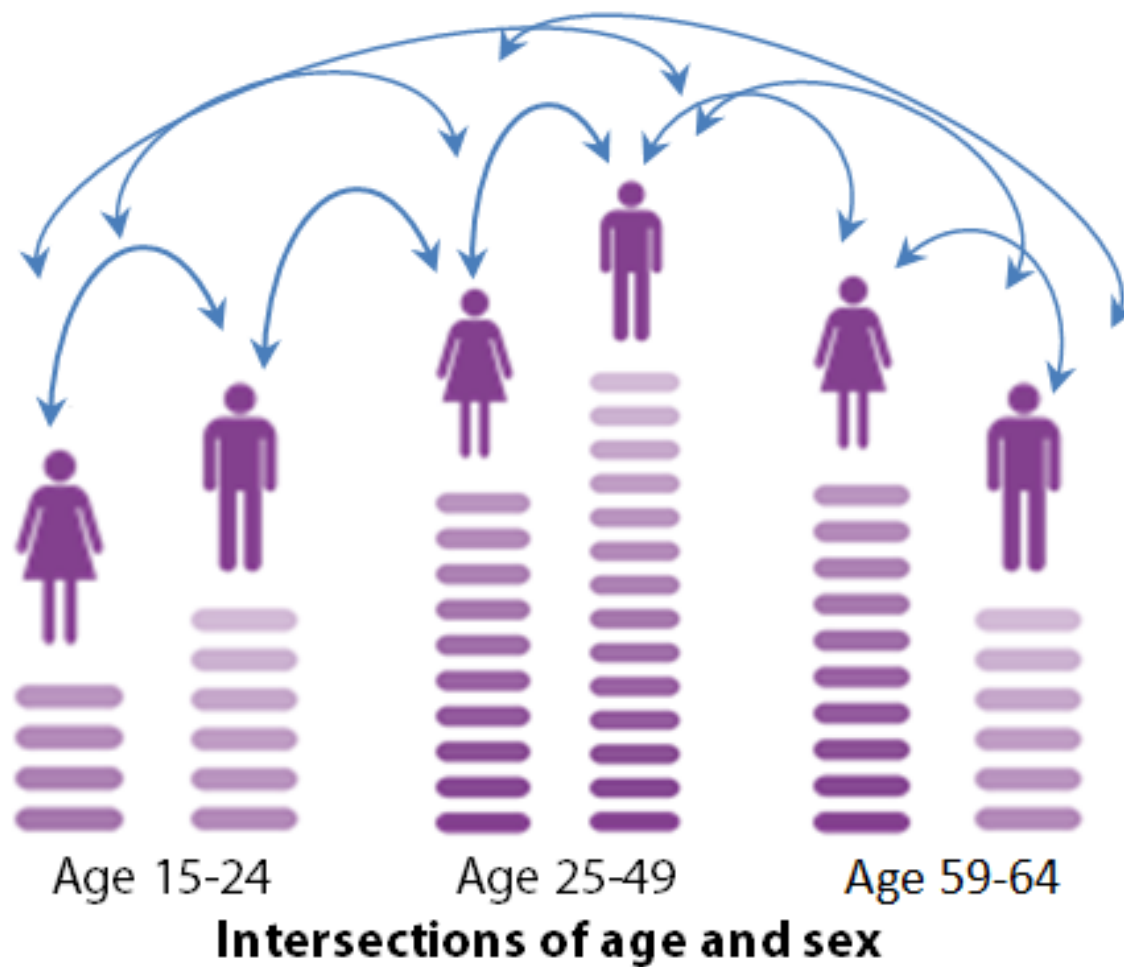
# Satellite domain: intersecting inequalities



- **Gender equality Index measures and monitors gender gaps but groups of women and men are not homogenous**
- Men and women have multiple identities: different age, nationality, race, sexual and gender identity, family composition, religious beliefs etc.
- Experiences are not a sum of two or more intersecting axis.
- These characteristics intersect and create different unique realities.



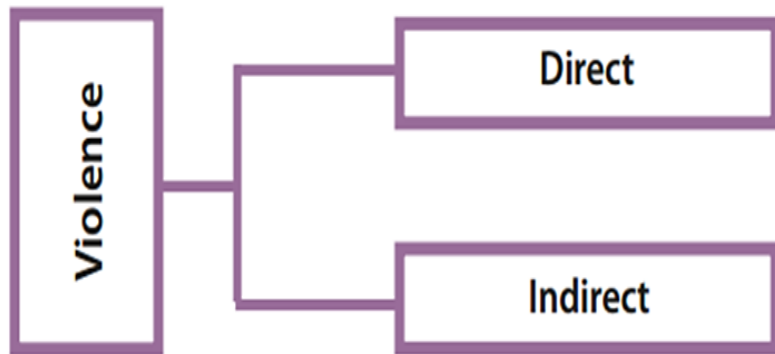

# Satellite domain: violence

EIGE's conceptual framework describes violence against women as a two-pronged phenomenon spanning direct and indirect violence



All acts of gender/based violence that result in, or are likely to result in, physical, sexual or psychological harm or suffering to an individual

Attitudes, stereotypes and cultural norms that underpin gendered practices

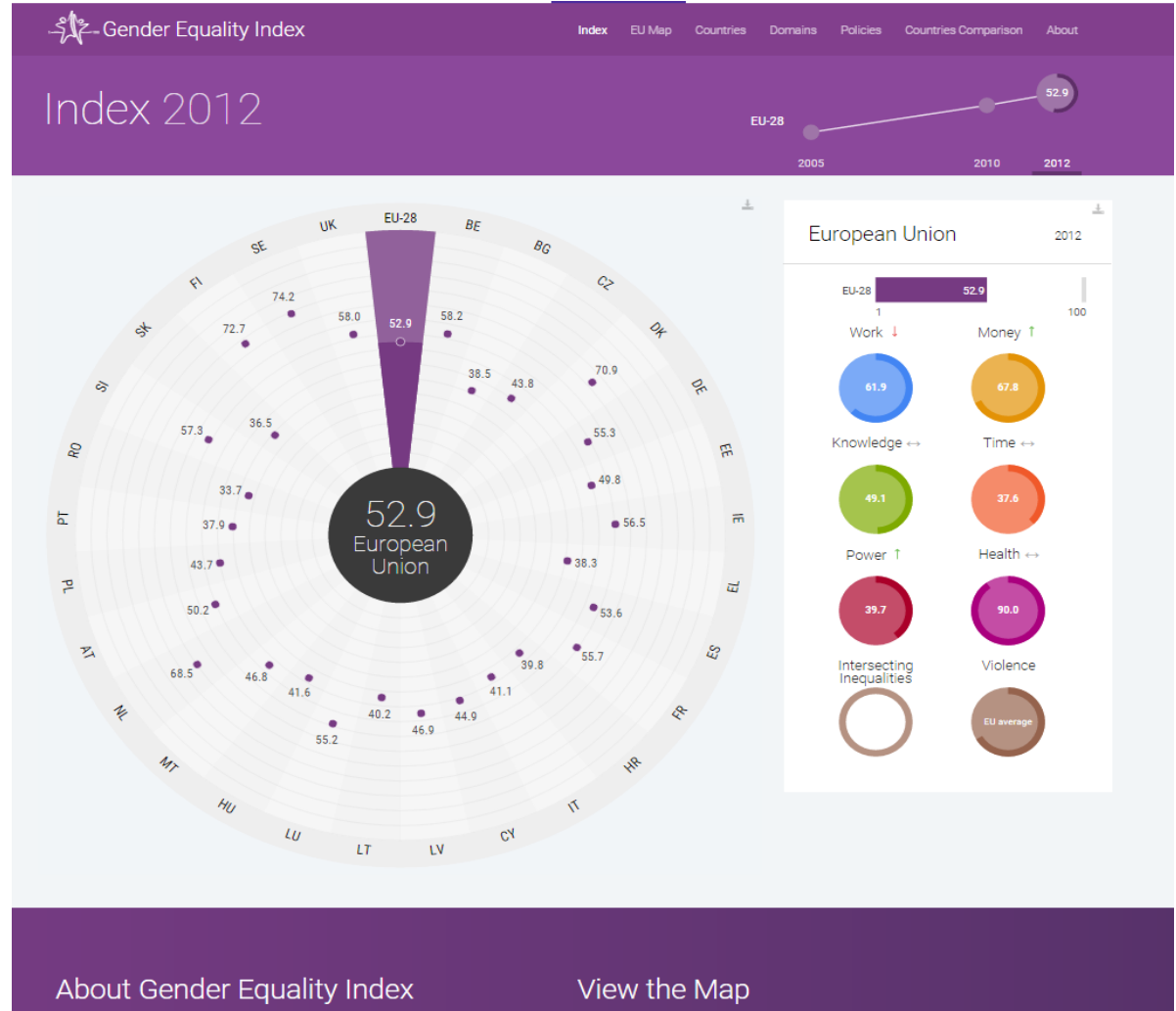

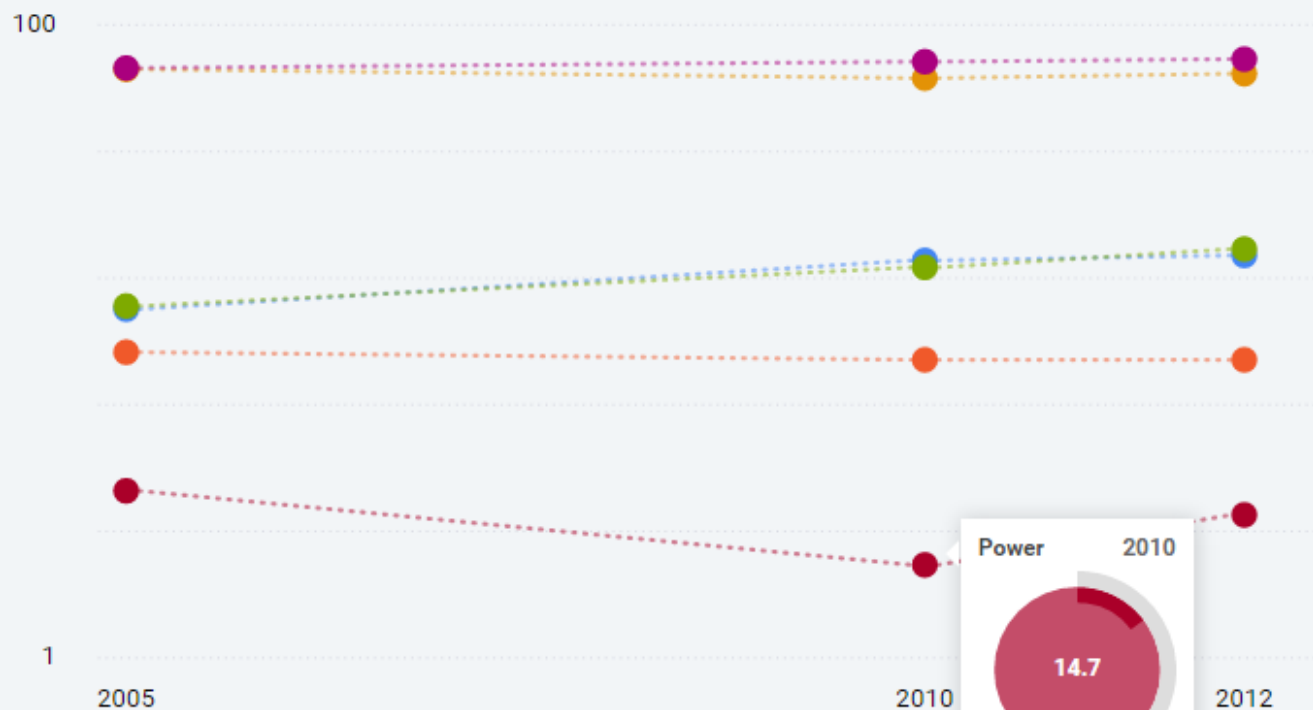

Sub domain	Concept measured	Variable
<b>Prevalence:</b>	Extent of violence against women in	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Intimate partner violence (physical and/or sexual), violence from a non partner, and/or sexual harassment since age 15</li> <li>- Intimate partner violence (physical and/or sexual), violence from a non partner, and/or sexual harassment in the past 12 months</li> <li>- Femicide</li> </ul>
<b>Severity:</b>	Severity of violence against women	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Health consequences of violence (may it violence from an intimate partner, a non partner or sexual harassment)</li> <li>- Multiple victimization through physical/sexual violence by an intimate partner, a non partner or through sexual harassment at work</li> </ul>
<b>Disclosure:</b>	Level of under-reporting of violence against women	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Women having experienced intimate partner violence (physical and/or sexual), violence from a non partner, and/or sexual harassment since age 15 and have not told anyone</li> <li>- Women having experienced intimate partner violence (physical and/or sexual), violence from a non partner, and/or sexual harassment in the past 12 months and have not told anyone</li> </ul>
