Subject: Adjustment of subsistence allowances for SNEs

Please find in annex the information relating to the adjustment of the subsistence allowances provided for in Article 17(1) of Commission Decision C(2008)6866 laying down rules on the secondment to the Commission of national experts and national experts in professional training as of 1 January 2018, which foresees in its Article 17(5) that the adjustment of such allowances follow the adjustments to remunerations and pensions.

Annex: Update of the subsistence allowance

Annex

In accordance with Article 65 of the Staff Regulations, the remuneration and pensions of officials and other servants will be increased by 1,7 % from 1 July 2018¹.

In the light of the foregoing, the amount of the subsistence allowance to be paid by the PMO pursuant Article 17(1) of Decision C(2008)6866, will be, from **1 January 2019**:

- a) the daily subsistence allowance:
paid pursuant Article 17(1) of Decision C(2008)6866: **140,49 €**

- b) the monthly subsistence allowance:
paid pursuant Article 17(1) of Decision C(2008)6866 on the basis of the distance between the place of origin/recruitment and the place of secondment:

Distance between place of origin and place of secondment (km)	Amount in €
0-150	0 €
>150	90,31 €
>300	160,54 €
>500	260,91 €
>800	421,46 €
>1300	662,30 €
>2000	792,77 €

The new correction coefficients applied to allowances for SNEs seconded outside Brussels and Luxembourg shall be effective as of 1 January 2019.
